### Lent reflection from LUKE 4:13-14

The devil has finished all his tempting of Jesus and Jesus returns to Galilee, empowered by the Spirit, to begin his public ministry. His time in the wilderness had been deeply formative, and it's not long before people take notice of who he is and what he's doing. Jesus demonstrates the truth of James 4:7: 'Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.' The devil's persistence has limits. Jesus' unwavering reliance on God left the devil sidelined, with no choice but to retreat.

Jesus' wilderness experience teaches us that by relying on God's strength, we can do more than resist the devil – we can press on confidently in our calling, wherever we are and whoever we are, actively participating in God's great work of reconciliation and renewal.
