Unstoppable: Living the Acts 1:8 life
A New Sermon Series on the Book of Acts

**Living in Community
of unity & generosity – Acts 4: 32-37**
Summary of Sermon by Karen Freeman 25.1.26

This sermon explores how the early church, empowered by the Holy Spirit, grew rapidly and lived in unity and generosity, sharing possessions and caring for one another. In contrast to a divided materialistic world, believers are called to be witnesses for Christ, united by faith but celebrating diversity. True unity means rising above disagreements and supporting each other with humility and love.

Practical ways to live this out include giving time, talents and treasures, volunteering, and showing generosity both within the church and in daily life. The importance of availability, willingness, and obedience was emphasised over capability or prominence.

The sermon concludes with a call to unity, generosity, and active love, encouraging the congregation to support one another and show Christ's love in the wider community.

Final prayer:

Let us with Christ within us, inspired by the Early Church, guided by God's word and filled with the power of the Holy Spirit be united as a Church go out into the divided world and not only share the good news of the gospel, but show how by believing and meeting Jesus we can cross divides, bridge our differences and become united in love. Amen

Thank you for all your donations to the Medway Foodbank between July – December 2025 which totalled 208.4kg. Your donations make a big difference to local people in crisis.



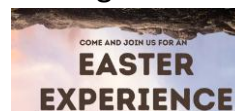
